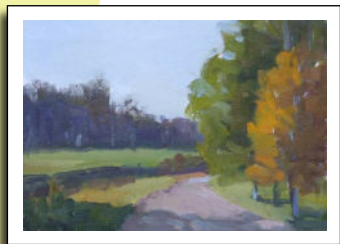

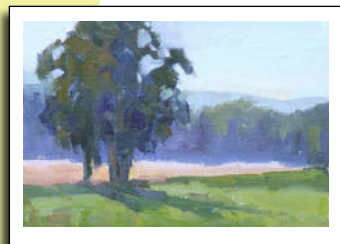

- Identifying the lights and darks
- Choosing the proper composition
- Painting from memory

Supplies :

- Portable easel or pochade box
- #4, #6 boars hair brushes
- Oil paints- Winton Brand of ultramarine blue, cad red med, Windsor Newton brand of cad yellow pale, titanium white
- Canvas boards- 10 5x7 or 6x8, 2 8x10
- Portable solvent container, gamsol unscented only solvent
- Note pad and pencil
- Viewfinder, color wheel, gray value scale
- Viva brand paper towels and trash bags
